

Nixon Accused on Press

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Nixon administration is leading a government assault on press freedom that goes far beyond “sophisticated news management, calculated deception or public-relations flackery,” Rep. William S. Moorhead said today.

“It involves governmental censorship, intimidation, the use of naked legal power to stop the newspaper presses, grand jury harrassment, legal action against legislators and publishers, and other, less direct methods of attack,” the Pennsylvania Democrat added.

He heads a House Government Information subcommittee.
