

Angela Loses Appeal on Bail

The California Court of Appeals yesterday denied without comment Angela Davis's petition for release on bail.

The one-sentence decision was written by Presiding Justice John B. Molinari. Joining him were Associate Justices Preston Devine and Norman Elkington.

Miss Davis is accused of supplying the weapons used in last year's unsuccessful escape attempt by three San Quentin prisoners.

Two prisoners, Marin county Superior Court Judge

Harold Haley and Jonathan Jackson, 17-year-old brother of "Soledad Brother" George Jackson, all died in the escape attempt at the Marin county Civic Center.

Miss Davis has been held without bail for nearly a year, on charges of murder and kidnaping.

Associate Justice Richard M. Sims, who normally sits on the three-judge panel which made the decision yesterday, disqualified himself, because he previously sat on the Marin county Superior Court bench with Judge Haley.
