

Rally Here Hits Death Of Jackson

A racially mixed group of about 125 persons marched from Alamo Square eight blocks to Duboce Park yesterday afternoon where they held a rally to protest the death of George Jackson and alleged racism in the California prison system.

The march was sponsored by the Progressive Labor Party, Students for a Democratic Society, and the Challenge Corps. Speakers condemned the killing of George Jackson and charged inmates in California prisons are being subjected to racist brutality by officials.

At its peak the marchers, about evenly mixed between blacks and whites, stretched a half block. The march and rally at Duboce Park were peaceful. The crowd was watched by four police patrol cars including members of the tactical squad.
