An error concerning James Kilty appeared in a news story in the Sunday Examiner of Feb. 13.

The article about the 1971-72 Marin grand jury referred to the indictment of seven convicts on murder charges last October, saying that three grand jury members "stormed from the jury's meeting room to protest the indictments."

The story said further that Kilty and the other two charged their fellow jurors with seeking "not justice, but vengeance."

Actually, Kilty left the jury room quietly, after the business had been concluded and with permission of the jury foreman. Kilty did not make the "not justice, but vengeance" comment. His remark to The Examiner at the time was: "It was a great disappointment to me, the way the vote went."
