

The Angela Bail-Poster Loses Suit

Rodger McAfee, the Fresno rancher who posted bail for Angela Davis, lost a San Francisco Municipal Court lawsuit yesterday.

Judge Harry Low ordered McAfee to pay \$3531 plus an estimated \$1000 interest to San Francisco architect Robert Batchelor.

The architect sued McAfee, claiming his firm spent 151 hours designing a 56-acre housing and commercial development near Fresno State College planned by McAfee. The rancher promised in 1966 to pay him for the professional services, Batchelor said.

McAfee denied they reached any agreement.

Judge Low heard the one-day trial on March 22. McAfee defended himself, while the architect was represented by San Francisco lawyer Jack Slobodif.
