Carr Death

Pair Plead

Not Guilty

SAN JOSE — Two accused slayers of black militant James E. Carr have pleaded not guilty to murder charges.

Lamarr Lloyd Mims, 21, of Los Angeles and Richard Rodriguez, 22, of Baldwin Park, entered the pleas yesterday before Superior Judge Bruce F. Allen.

Judge Allen set their trial for June 12.

The two are accused of the hired killing of Carr April 6 in an ambush shooting as he left his mother-in-law's home.

Carr, a former cellmate of George Jackson, was living in the home of Joan Hammer, his mother-in-law and one of the organizers of the Solédad Brothers defense fund, when he was murdered.
