

# Pro-Angela Protesters Sentenced

SAN JOSE -- Some 22 supporters of Angela Davis have been given 30 day suspended jail sentences and placed on six months probation for picketing outside her courtroom.

San Jose-Milpitas Municipal Judge Wayne M. Kanamoto yesterday granted probation on condition that they not engage in picketing or parading outside courtrooms during that time.

The 22 had been found guilty of violating a recently enacted state law prohibiting picketing with the intent to influence courts on Jan. 31 and Feb. 2.

Miss Davis sister, Fania Jordan, and one of the coordinators of the National United Committee to Free Angela Davis, Charlene Mitchell, were among those sentenced.

Franklin Alexander, another NUCFAD coordinator, had his sentencing continued to June 2 to allow completion of a probation report.
