

Panthers Hail Verdict, Blast Judicial System

The Black Panther party yesterday expressed "great satisfaction" over the acquittal of Angela Davis and attacked the American judicial system for trying her in the first place.

"We are naturally very happy that Angela has been relieved of all the charges that were falsely brought against her," said Elanie Brown, Black Panther minister of information in Oakland.

"We do not give credit to the American judicial system for declaring her innocent," she added. "She has had to endure one year of prison unnecessarily because of that system."
