# Angela Leaving On Tour

SAN JOSE—Angela Davis was scheduled to leave today on a nationwide tour to thank supporters — her trip cut to four cities on doctor's orders.

Miss Davis, suffering from exhaustion, was limited to an engagement in Los Angeles tonight and appearances in Chicago, Detroit and New York.

"For the first time in 22 months, the pressure is off and she's literally out on her feet," said spokesman Stephanie Allan.

After a week's rest at an undisclosed spot, Miss Davis will speak June 16 in Chicago, June 18, in Detroit, rest 10 days and then appear at an "Evening with Angela Davis" on June 29 in New York's Madison Garden.

The 28 year old Black Communist, who was acquitted Sunday by an all white jury on murder

kidnap-conspiracy charges stemming from the Aug. 7, 1970, shootout at the Marin County Civic Center, will then leave for "an extended visit" to either Bulgaria or the Soviet Union.

Miss Davis' physician cut short a more extended tour she planned to Memphis, Tenn. and her hometown, Birmingham, Ala.
