**Angry Magee
Calls Judge
'Insane'**

Ruchell Magee walked out of the pre-trial hearings in the murder case against him again yesterday after calling Superior Court Judge Morton Colvin "insane."

Magee had offered a motion for a change of venue from California to "any other state" because "a conflict of interest exists between the defense and the entire California judicial system."

Colvin answered that the motion was the same as one previously denied and that he would receive it but not file it.

SHOUTS

A brief shouting match broke out ending with Magee saying:

"Man, you is insane!"

Then he let out a long whoop and walked out of the court to a holding cell from which he could hear the proceedings.

The judge denied a defense motion to drop the charge against Magee for lack of a speedy trial.

WALKOUT

Since Monday's hearings, Magee had walked out seven times and was ejected by force twice. Yesterday also was his sixth day of court

appearance in San Francisco. He had 33 previous court appearances in Marin county, some with Angela Davis.

Magee, a 33-year-old San Quentin inmate, is accused of murder, kidnap, conspiracy and assault stemming from the 1970 escape attempt and gun battle at the Marin Civic Center.

No date is set for the next hearing.
