THE COPYRIGHTED STORY BY TIMES HERALD REPORTER JIM LEHRER QUOTED "UNIMPEACHABLE SOURCES."

THE STORY SAID THE DISCIPLINARY ACTION WAS TAKEN ON ORDERS FROM THE OFFICE OF J. EDGAR HOOVER, FRI DIRECTOR.

THE WARREN COMMISSION CRITICISM OF THE FRI IN ITS REPORT ON THE ASSASSINATION, THE SOURCE SAID, WAS A DIRECT CAUSE OF THE SUSPENSION. THREE OTHER FEI AGENTS RECEIVED LETTERS OF CENSURE LAST WEEK.

THE 30-DAY SUSPENSION WAS EFFECTIVE LAST MONDAY. DURING THE SUSPENSION, HOSTY, FATHER OF LIGHT CHILDREN, WILL NOT BE PAID. HE WILL THEN REPORT FOR DUTY IN MANSAS CITY.

FBI HEADQUARTERS IN WASHINGTON ALSO REFUSED TO COMMENT. PROBATION AND HAD RECEIVED A LETTER OF CENSURE. THESE TOOK PLACE AFTER THE ASSASSIMATION BUT BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORTED. THE TIMES HERALD SAID.

HOSTY WAS AN INTERNAL SECURITY EXPERT. HE ROUTINELY INVESTIGATED GSVALD EARLY IN MOVEMBER. THE WARREN COMMISSION CONCLUDED THAT CSWALD KILLED PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY NOV. 22 IN DALLAS.

TESTINONY BEFORE THE COMMISSION SHOWED THAT HOSTY INTERVIEWED HRS. RUTH PAINE, WITH WHOM HRS. CSWALD LIVED, AND CONFIRMED THAT OSVALD WORKED AT THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY FROM WHERE THE SHOTS WERE FIRED. THE COMMISSION SAID NO FEI AGENT INTERVIEWED OSVAL AFTER AUG. 10, 1963.

THE WARREN COMMISSION SAID HOSTY SHOULD HAVE INTERVIEWED OSWALD IN VIEW OF THE APPROACHING VISIT OF KERNEDY TO DALLAS. THE COMMISSION ALSO SAID THE FOI TOOK AN UNDULY RESTRICTIVE VIEW ABOUT ITS RESPONSIBILITY FOR REPORTING OSVALD'S PRESENCE TO THE SECRET SERVICE, CHARGED WITH PROTECTING THE PRESIDENT.

HOSTY TOLD THE COMMISSION THAT NONE OF THE INFORMATION KNOWN ABOUT TOSVALD AT THE TIME FITTED INTO THE MATERIAL VANTED BY THE SECRET

SERVICE. THE YET HAS CONTENDED THAT NONE OF ITS AGENTS DID WRONG.
HOSTY AND THE DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT GOT INTO A DISPUTE AFTER
THE PRESIDENT WAS SLAIM. POLICE LY. JACK REVILL REPORTED IN A
HEMORANDUM THAT HOSTY TOLD HIM AFTER THE ASSASSINATION THAT THE FEI
KNEW OSWALD HAD THE CAPABILITY OF SHOOTING THE PRESIDENT. HOSTY DENIED
MAKING THE STATEMENT.

THE TIMES HERALD IN AN EARLIER COPYRIGHTED STORY SAID THAT HOSTY'S INMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN DALLAS HAD BEEN DEMOTED AND THAT A NEW ORIZANS AGENT HAD BEEN GIVEN A DISCIPLINARY TRANSFER BUT REFUSED TO ACCEPT IT AND RESIGNED.

HOSTY, IN HIS LATE 308, IS A MATTVE OF CHICAGO AND A GRADUATE OF MOTRE DAME, HIS YOUNGEST CHILD IS ONE YEAR OLD AND THE FAMILY IS EXPECTING ANOTHER CHILD.
