

GIRL [Leslie Bacon] SEIZED AS WITNESS IN BOMBING OF U.S. CAPITOL

Washington, April 28 - Agents of the [FBI] arrested a 19-year-old girl here last night as a material witness for a grand jury in Seattle that is looking into the bombing of the United States Capitol on March 1. They arrested her on a roof near a commune in which she lived.

According to residents in the lower-middle-class, racially mixed neighborhood in northwest Washington, four gray cars filled with F.B.I. men, some with long hair and wearing rumpled clothes, pulled up around 7 last night and went through two houses on Lanier Place in search of the girl, Leslie Bacon.

Observers here point out that the bombing is one of two unsolved cases under which the F.B.I. is feeling pressure because of the direct concern of Congress. The other case is the burglary at the F.B.I. office at Media, Pa., that has resulted in the public dissemination of a number of F.B.I. files.
