

Defense Plea in Berrigan Case

[Story by UPI says Leonard Boudin, attorney for Harrisburg Seven - in asking court for special hearing - notes that Boyd F. Douglas and Robert W. Hardy were both informers for the FBI, "adopted leadership roles," provided "indispensable physical and informational needs," and each offered to provide a weapon; both Douglas and Hardy had worked through the same FBI agent, William Anderson. Hearing is requested to determine if government used entrapment in the case of Harrisburg Seven as it did in Camden draft board raids.]
