

Hoover Urged To Apologize

The Lutheran Human Relations Association of America yesterday urged J. Edgar Hoover, director of the FBI, to apologize to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The Board also wrote to acting Attorney General Nicholas B. Katzenbach, urging him to "guard carefully against such reckless outbursts by your department personnel" and said the attack was "gross ingratitude and grave folly" because it might cause people to doubt the cause King "has so effectively led."
