WASHINGTON, MARCH 29 (AP)-FBI DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER
ASSAILED TODAY "DRUMMERS OF DISCORD" WHO HE SAID ADVOCATE THAT THE
FBI "DISPENSE WITH THE DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND
APPLY POLICE-STATE METHODS."

HOOVER REITERATED THAT HIS FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION "IS A FACT-GATHERING AND FACT-REPORTING AGENCY, NOT A NATIONAL POLICE FORCE."

THE FBI, HE SAID, "IS NOT EMPOWERED TO FURNISH PROTECTION NOR TO POLICE THE STREETS OF OUR COMMUNITIES."

WRITING IN THE FBI'S APRIL LAW ENFORCEMENT BULLETIN, THE FBI
CHIEF NAMED NO CRITICS BUT SAID "SOME INDIVIDUALS IN THEIR EFFORTS
TO SECURE THE FUNDAMENTAL GUARANTEES OF THE CONSTITUTION FOR ALL
CITIZENS, HAVE CRITICIZED THIS BUREAU FOR NOT EXCEEDING ITS AUTHORITY
AND FOR NOT ASSUMING RESPONSIBILITIES BELONG TO LOCAL AND STATE
POLICE."

HOOVER SAID CITIZENS "SHOULD NOT BE MISLED BY THE SELF-STYLED "MEDICINE MEN' IN OUR MIDST WHO WITH THEIR PATENTED TONICS FOR ALL SOCIAL ILLS PROFESS TO HOLD THE MAGIC KEY TO UTOPIA.

"UNDER CLOSE EXAMINATION, THEIR CREDENTIALS OFTEN PROVE TO BE AS FALSE AS THEIR CHARGES THAT THE FBI IS 'DRAGGING ITS FEET' AND IS NOT DETERMINED TO ENFORCE CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS. THE LUDICROUSNESS OF THESE CHARGES IS EXCEEDED ONLY BY THEIR INACCURACY."

TERMING A NATIONAL POLICE FORCE A "TOOL OF TYRANNY" HOOVER SAID:

"I ABHOR THE IMPLICATIONS OF THE TERM, AND I REFUSE TO LET THE FBI
BE FORCED INTO PRACTICES WHICH SMACK OF POLICE-STATE

RETIONS,
BE FORCED INTO PRACTICES WHICH SMACK OF POLICE-STATE ACTIONS,
REGARDLESS OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES." HE SAID THE FBI-FULLY APPRECIATES
THE GRAVE RESPONSIBILITY INHERRENT IN THE INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED
VIOLATIONS OF FEDERAL CIVIL RIGHTS STATUTES.

"AS I HAVE STATED MANY TIMES, WE ARE MEETING THESE OBLIGATIONS WITHOUT APOLOGY. OUR ROLE, HOWEVER, IS THAT OF AN INVESTIGATOR--NOT AN ACCUSER, PROSECUTOR, JURY OR JUDGE....

"IN A DEMOCRACY, THE END DOES NOT ALWAYS JUSTIFY THE MEANS. WE MUST NOT LOSE SIGHT OF THE FACT THAT THE PATH OF JUSTICE IS A TWO-WAY STREET....THE FREEDOMS AND RIGHTS OF OUR NATION CAN BE IMPLEMENTED, AS WELL AS PRESERVED, WITHOUT RESORTING TO TOTALITARIAN TACTICS."
