Funeral for Wife Of Controversial Ex-FBI Agent

Funeral services for Mrs. John (Jack) F. Shaw Sr., 36, wife of a well-known former FBI agent, will be held here today.

Mrs. Shaw, whose husband was pressured into resigning from the FBI by Director J. Edgar Hoover, died Wednesday at a New York hospital after a lengthy illness. Survivors include four children. ages 6 to 9.

Shaw resigned from the FBI last September rather than accept a disciplinary transfer from New York to Butte, Mont. Shaw, whose wife suffered from Cancer. wrote Hoover a letter citing the "health, happiness and welfare" of his family as the reason for resigning.

Hoover, who accused Shaw of "atrocious judgment" in writing a letter to a college professor critical of the FBI. accepted the resignation "with prejudice." Shaw has said the black mark has prevented him from getting another law enforcement job.
