New Glomar Try To Raise Russ Sub

Long Beach

The salvage ship Glomar Explorer, operated by Howard Hughes' Summa Corp., reportedly on secret CIA missions, will leave July 4 for a second attempt to raise a Russian submarine from the bottom of the Pacific ocean, it was reported yesterday.

The ship will rendezvous at sea with the huge barge

that it uses in salvage work, according to City News Service.

The Glomar Explorer last summer got part of the Russian sub off the bottom with its huge crane, but the Central Intelligence Agency reportedly has ordered another effort to recover important equipment that might indicate the vessel's atomic capability.
