

Glomar Explorer Shows Up After 2 Days of Mystery

AVALON, Calif., Aug. 23 (UPI)—The Glomar Explorer made a surprise appearance Saturday morning, anchoring off the west end of Catalina Island after two days of mystery over her whereabouts.

No one was available to comment on how long the Glomar was expected to stay, why she was here or where she had been.

The ship was used by the Central Intelligence Agency last year in a partly successful attempt to raise a sunken Soviet submarine in the north Pacific.

The Glomar left the harbor in Long Beach, 26 miles away, on Thursday for secret tests off Catalina Island, a voyage that takes several hours.
