

**ARMY AGENT REPORTS  
FILES ON ABERNATHY**

CHICAGO, Dec. 29 (UPI)—A former Army intelligence agent testified Tuesday that Army surveillance of civilians included dossiers on the Rev. Ralph David Abernathy, head of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, and the Rev. James E. Groppi, leader of civil rights militants in Milwaukee.

John M. O'Brien, 26 years

old, was on the witness stand for the second day in a hearing before Federal District Judge Richard B. Austin on a motion to force the Army to stop surveillance of civilians.

Mr. O'Brien, who served as an investigator for the 113th Military Intelligence Group, testified that among his duties was the collection of information on "mobile surveillance" near the home of a prominent Winnetka, Ill., businessman during a party in October, 1969, attended by members of the Students Mobilization Committee.
