
Surveillance Probe at Community Colleges

A trustee of the community colleges called yesterday for a full-scale investigation by the Justice Department into allegations of illegal electronic surveillance of students and faculty.

The American Federation of Teachers, the American Civil Liberties Union and the Western Center on Law and Poverty filed a \$1 million

lawsuit Monday, claiming the college district had engaged in the illegal practices.

Dr. Monroe Richmond said: "Should the investigation substantiate that illegal surveillance has been indeed been conducted on our campuses, I will demand the resignation of those responsible."
