

Mental Test Scheduled For Bremer

JESSUP (Md.) — (UPI) — Psychiatrists scheduled mental examinations today for Arthur Herman Bremer, the former Milwaukee busboy charged with the shooting of Alabama Gov. George Wallace.

FBI agents transferred Bremer, 21, from the Baltimore County Jail in pre-dawn secrecy yesterday to the maximum security Clifton T. Perkins State Hospital here, about 20 miles south of Baltimore.

Judge Ralph Powers ordered the mental examinations after Bremer changed his plea from innocent to innocent by reason of insanity to 17 state charges in the shooting of Wallace and three others May 15 at a Laurel, Md., political rally.

State trial of Bremer is set for July 12 and federal trial five days later.

Three psychiatrists previously have examined Bremer, including two appointed by the federal court who have not released their findings. A third, unidentified

psychiatrist examined him at a hospital the night of the shooting and recommended full testing.
