Trial Jury

Chosen

UPPER MARLBORO (Md.) — (AP) — A jury of six men and six women was selected rapidly today as Arthur H. Bremer went on trial for the attempted assassination of Alabama Gov. George Wallace.

A panel of seven women and five men was first chosen but pre-emptory challenges by attorneys altered the composition. Two male alternates were then selected.

It took the judge and opposing attorneys a little more than an hour to choose the jury.

Bremer has pleaded innocent by reason of insanity.

The 21 year old Bremer appeared at ease as he sat watching the proceedings in the tightly guarded courtroom.

A total of 36 prospective jurors were questioned before the jury was impaneled.
