

Keystone Kops At Convention

TALLAHASSEE (Fla.) — (AP) — Armed security agents were so numerous at Miami Beach hotels during the Democratic National Convention that they were arresting each other, a state report says.

The quarterly report of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement released yesterday showed two

armed men arrested at the campaign headquarters of Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace by agents of the state protective intelligence squad and the U.S. Secret Service.

The two were released a department spokesman said, when it was determined they were properly licensed security agents.
