# Wallace Has Surgery-- Satisfactory

Birmingham, Ala.

Governor George Wallace underwent surgery yesterday for an enlarged prostate gland and to correct urinary trouble.

His doctor said the operation went without complications.

Wallace, 53, who was paralyzed by a bullet wound May 15, 1972, was listed as in satisfactory condition.

The enlarged prostate was not caused by the shooting, but was hampering the flow of urine from the bladder, doctors said.
