

Notes on People James F. Clarity

**Gov. George C. Wallace** of Alabama is expected to be released from a Birmingham hospital this week, nearly a month after surgery to remove his prostate gland. Mr. Wallace will be returning home to Montgomery amid speculation that he is physically unable to function as Governor and still somewhat depressed about his condition.

Mr. Wallace has been paralyzed from the waist down and has undergone surgery six times since he was shot at a rally in Maryland last May. But he has begun to appear more frequently in public; he made a weekend appearance, traveled to Huntsville on Monday to plant two trees in honor of American servicemen missing in Vietnam.
