The agents asked for Sloan; Stans told them 'Sloan had resigned two weeks ago.' But according to a later deposition by Sloan, he did not resign until later that day, after Stans told him what he had told the FBI."
- (In Sloan's testimony before Ervin committee he says he called Stans the evening of 13 Jul 72, told him he was considering resigning and asked to see him the following day. Stans said he had an appointment with FBI agents in the morning in his office, told Sloan not to come into the toom while they were there, and that he would get in touch with him following that meeting.)
