Says gov't case "[offends] a sense of justice."

After Judge Byrne had discharged the jury, mexnimecuhoc momentedcanxthexcemecusexereicsayctheyxthought nine comment on the case and several say they think the case would have ended in acquittal; none say hecwowly they would have voted guilty.
