Haig - Comptroller General Elmer Staats, in reply to enquiry by Rep. John Moss (D-Calif), says in letter dated today that he has ruled that Gen. Haig is violating federal law by serving as Nixon's staff aide while still on active military duty. "Moss originally questioned Haig's civilian role several weeks ago. [Nixon announced 4 May that Haig was succeeding Haldeman.] The White House then announced Haig would retire from the Army on Aug. 1."
