Ervin, just before committee's lunch recess, recives phone call supposedly from Treasury Secretary George P. Shultz, to say that committee would be given tapes of presidential conversations and that Nixon would meet with Ervin during the coming week to discuss procedures (to be used in turning over the tapes?). Ervin announces this as afternoon session opens but very shortly after that makes second announcement to say the call was apparenly a "hoax," that WH had called the committee, after which Ervin called Shultz, who toldhim he had not spoken to Ervin.

Nixon, in the hospital and due to leave the following day, begins drafting letter to committee which, according to "informed sources", will say he will not release the tapes in question. No indication whether this draft was started before or after "hoax" call. Letter is to be sent to the committee Monday morning [23 Jul], before any meeting is set with Ervin.

Tapes - "Sources on Capitol Hill" say Laird has told congressional leaders he believes pertinent sections of the tapes should be released. Among proposals suggested by other White House aides who wan think Nixon should make the tapes public is the appointment of a special reviewing officer who would listen to the tapes and decide which were relevant. Possible candidates, two former Republican senators, John J. Williams of Delaware and John Sherman Cooper of Kentucky. Dash says committee "would settle for nothing less" than the full tapes; would not accept a summary or a report on their contents.
