Nixon "assassination plot" - William Claiborne says there were five separate unrelated incidents, four of which proved to have nothing to do with an assassinatin plot; Secret Service, FBI and police are left with what they regard as one serious plot, by members of Black Panther party. Claiborne says information about this "plot" was given to New Orleans police by Secret Service, which asked for arrest of six men until Nixon visit was over; police refused because there was not enough evidence, but did keep the men under surveillance.
