Impeachment - Roper poll of 2020 persons interviewed "in early November [no precise date given] before the disclosure of the 18-minute gap in a key White House tape" shows 45 to 44 per cent against impeachment, but "indications are that opposition stems not from belief in the President's innocence but from fear of the destructive effect an impeachment proceeding would have," and "most of the concern of those polled ... seemed to center on the President's withholding of information."

The ACLU was one of the subscribers to this poll and describes it as "the most complete and in-depth study on attitudes toward impeachment and does not have the inherent bias of other polls that simply ask for a yes or no answer on the impeachment question."
