Nixon (Supreme Court) - According to Time magazine today, Dean says Nixon was prepared to defy the Supreme Court if it had ruled against allowing the underground atomic test at Amchitka in 1971.

Defiance of Supreme Court - See entry, Nixon, Supreme Court.

Ellsberg (national security) - Handwritten notes by Ehrlichman quote Nixon as saying 17 Jun 71 that damaging information on Ellsberg must be leaked to the press - "that is the way we win" - and that the case "must be tried in the papers." Nixon advises Ehrlichman to read the Alger Hiss chapter in "Six Crises," saying, "It was won in the press."

NYT printed first installment of Penatgon Papers 13 Jun 71; temporary restraining order ggainst the Times was issued 15 Jun 71. "According to Nixon administration sources, the [Pentagon] Papers were delivered to the [Soviet] embassy ... on June 16, 1971."

Ehrlichman's notes were turned over to HJC by special prosecutor's office 15 Jul 74; released 20 Jul 74.
