Pardons - Sens. Alan Cranston and Edward W. Brooke introduce sense of the Senate resolution that pardons of any defendant or prospective defendant in Watergate offenses should not be considered until after the judicial process has been fully completed, including the exhaustion of all rights of appeal.

Cranston and Brooke are joined in the resolution by Sens. Robert C. Byrd, Philip A. Hart, Richard S. Schweicker, Jacob Javits, Charles Mathias, and Abraham Ribicoff.
