Nixon (1969 taxes) - "Although the Internal Revenue Service discovered [Nixon's] \$148,000 tax debt for 1969 too late to enforce collection, Nixon promised to pay anyway. According to the IRS, Nixon did not pay as promised. Ironically, if he had, he probably would come under an obscure IRS ruling that permits such late, voluntary taxpayers to get refunds of the entire amount."

Nixon (party for staff) - Nixon gives party at San Clemente Inn for members of transition staff who are leaving since transition period ends tomorrow. Nixon stays 30 minutes.

"Some of those present said [Nixon] walked without a limp and seemed to enjoy especially the 'roasting' of his military aide, Col. Jack Brennan." Korff (see entry 9 Feb, Korff press conference) says he himself did not attend; "I could not face the extreme effort I knew he would undertake to hide his frustrations and appear gregarious because he didn't want his staff to take away an impression of hopelessness."
