Butterfield - Rep. Jack Brooks, chairman of House Government Operations Committee, "called today for the Federal Aviation Administration to improve and enforce safety regulations for the air shipment of hazardous materials. [He] sent a letter to the F.A.A. Administrator, Alexander P. Butterfield, asking for a report within two weeks on what action the agency had taken or intended to take on a series of 16 recommendations of the National Transportation Safety Board."

This seems to imply Brooks' letter was written today, although no date is given for it. If so, Butterfield is still with the FAA; see entry 6 Feb, Butterfield "is understood .... "
