Nixon-Thieu letters - Charles Hamilton, an authority on signatures, says he does not believe Mixon himself signed the letters to Thieu; says that in Mixon's signature the second "r" in "Richard" and the "o" in Mixon are always omitted, but are included in the signatures on the letters published 30 Apr. as they are in routine correspondence and photographs in 1963 and 1972. Hamilton says he thinks the letters to Thieu were probably signed by Rose MaryMoods.

Korff says the collapse of South Vietnam "deeply affected" Mixon and caused a rise in his blood pressure.

Story does not say where or when Korff made this statement - perhaps when announcing another payment to Mixon's lawyers? Story does not say such a payment was made, but does say Korff is committed to paying \$400,000 of Mixon's legal bills, of which \$165,000 has been paid. Last mention of such a payment, in file, was 27 Mar 75 (see entry that date), when the payments totaled \$145,000. Korff says his fund collects about \$20,000 a month.

Story, which is undated, appears in "Notes on People."
Payments by Norff usually have been made about the 26th of
the month (see entry 26 Apr); the new figure given today
may represent the payment for Apr. See entry 28 May, Korff.
