Watergate, third anniversary - General story on the anniversary, listing some of the questions still unanswered.

"The great bulk of the prosecutions are over - and the toll comes to more than 50, including three of Mr. Nixon's Cabinet members and 20 of his White House and re-election aides."

"A spokesman for the Watergate special prosecutor, Henry S. Ruth Jr., said that indictments could be forthcoming from other grand juries even after the third and final Watergate grand jury expires, but he noted that there was a vast difference between the possibility and likelihood of indictments. Jill Wine-Volner, an assistant prosecutor who handled much of the tapes investigation, hinted to reporters last month that she believed no indictments were likely in the matter of the 18½-minute gap. Another person in a position to know said he knew of no indication there would be further key indictments."
