Nixon (Senate intelligence committee) - Sen. John Tower, committee vice-chairman, has phone conversation with Nixon today, "about matters of interest to the select committee," and will report to the committee when it meets 29 Jul to (WXP:) "discuss the prospects of obtaining [Nixon's] testimony for its investigation of the [CIA].... The senators apparently want to question Nixon, in California if necessary, about covert CIA operations in Chile against the late President Salvador Allende. They have also expressed interest in securing Nixon's testimony about CIA operations in Greece and about domestic spying on U.S. citizens in recent years."
