"Stans' statement [to the GAO?] said Andreas agreed on March 10 to contribute the \$25,000 to Mr. Nixon's campaign. Stans said a few days later that Andreas placed the \$25,000 in cash in the safe of a Miami Beach hotel and advised Dahlberg that the cash could be picked up by the Republicans. Stans said the April 5 call to Dahlberg came when Andreas discovered that the cash had not been picked up and that the money was now being placed in a safe deposit box at the hotel in Dahlberg's name."

"The [\$25,000] was to be left in a safety-deposit box in a Bal Harbour, Fla., hotel, earmarked for Dahlberg."

Newsweek 4 Sep 72

"The [Seaview] hotel's safety deposit was closed for the night [8 Apr]. The next day Andreas withdrew \$25,000 in cash from the safety deposit box and gave it to Dahlberg ... "

"In a later interview, Mr. Dahlberg told [the GAO?] that the donor was Mr. Andreas and that he was handed the money [presumably by Andreas] on April 9 on a golf course in the Miami area."

Dahlberg converted the \$25,000 in cash into a cashier's check drawn on First Bank and Trust Company, Boca Raton, 10 Apr 72; gave it to Stans 11 Apr 72.
