

Democratic Headquarters Emptied by Bomb Threat

WASHINGTON, Oct. 5 (Reuters)—Workers were evacuated from the Democratic national party headquarters today after telephoned bomb threats, the police said.

Employees at the Federal Reserve Board, whose offices are nearby; were also evacuated after a call to the board's switchboard.

Policemen with dogs searched the office buildings as deadlines for explosions passed without incident. No bombs were found.
