F.B.I. Asked to Study Florida Smear Letter

TAMPA, Fla., Oct. 21 United States Attorney John Briggs said in Jacksonville Saturday the Federal Bureau of Investigation had been asked to investigate an anonymous letter smearing Senator Henry M. Jackson and Hubert H. Humphrey. The letter, written on stationery of Senator Edmund S. Muskie, was mailed to prospective voters just before the Presidential primary in Florida last March

Senator Jackson's staff had asked the Government to investigate at the time to determine if postal laws had been violated. Mr. Briggs, explaining why an inquiry had not begun until now, said that the letter sent to his office in March was not accompanied by an envelope proving that it had been sent through the mails.
