

# Shriver Links Nixon

## With Hired 'Saboteur'

WORCESTER, (Mass.) — (AP) — Sargent Shriver says President Nixon "had to know" Republican recruiter for saboteurs and spies to disrupt the Democrats.

Both the President and Donald Segretti apparently were at the same hotel on the same day, 24 days after he was hired, Shriver said — in Portland's Benson Hotel Sept. 24 and 25, 1971.

Nixon was in Portland on a stopover before flying to

Alaska to meet with the emperor of Japan.

Shriver addressed a cheering and foot-stomping rally at Holy Cross College. He hit again at what he called Nixon's failure to end the Vietnam war, mimicking Nixon's recent statement on TV that: "I believe in keeping the promises I make."

Nixon's chief promise four years ago was peace in Vietnam, and he hasn't kept it, Shriver said, and added:

"He says he doesn't want

to be 'stampeded' into peace. We say we don't want to be buffaloes into any more wars."

Shriver suggested, but did not say directly, that Nixon and Segretti were in the Portland hotel to discuss political espionage.

Segretti, who lives in Los Angeles, has not been available for comment on reports that he hired persons for the Committee for Re-Election of the President to sabotage the Democratic campaign
