

Watergate Case Cubans Aided By Compatriots

MIAMI, April 20 (AP)—A 14-man committee, calling itself "The Committee of Help," has opened five bank accounts here to provide financial aid for the four Miami men convicted of taking part in the Watergate break-in.

Reinaldo Vergara said yesterday the committee has collected between "\$3,000 and \$4,000." He said none of the cash came from the Committee for the Re-election of the President or Republican Party sources.

"We have nothing to do with any political thing," Vergara said. "We are not concerned if they are guilty or not."

"They are decent people," he added. "Whatever they did, if they did anything, was to help this country in the fight against communism. We are a group of Cubans helping other Cubans."
