Nixon Urged to 'Clean House'

PITTSBURGH — (UPI) — Sen. Richard S. Schweiker (R-Pa.) says the only way to restore public confidence in the Nixon administration is to replace the White House staff with "men of integrity and intelligence."

Schweiker said the presidential aides linked to the Watergate case should be dismissed now before further indictments are made in connection with the bugging incident.

He praised the news media for uncovering the scandal.
