

## Sen. Kennedy Sees Damage to Country

BOSTON, April 26 (UPI)

—Sen. Edward Kennedy (D-Mass.) said yesterday that the Watergate case and subsequent investigation has been damaging to the country.

"Watergate affects the whole relationship between the Executive and the American people, and our relationship with countries throughout the world," Kennedy said. "I feel a sense of sadness about its implications with regard to the office of the presidency and the country."

Kennedy made his remarks before a student audience at Suffolk University.
