Coverup Plot

New York

Former Attorney General John N. Mitchell denied yesterday that he conspired with at least three Nixon administration officials to arrange a coverup story to obstruct a federal investigation into the full ramifications of the Watergate break-in.

Mitchell issued the following denial: "A story appearing in today's New York Times alleging that I conspired with H. R. Haldeman, John Ehrlichman and John Dean to obstruct justice in the Watergate case is absolutely false and without factual foundation."
