A Cry That Broke Up The Hearing

The Senate Watergate hearings were interrupted yesterday by a young man in a blue suit who stood at the rear of the room, waved his arms in a "V" sign and shouted, "My name is Ed Kelley and I'm announcing for the presidency of the United States."

Senator Sam J. Ervin (Dem - N.C.), chairman of the select investigating committee, gaveled for order as Capitol policemen hustled the spectator outside. "The chair will announce this is not a political forum for the announcing of candidacies," Ervin said with a grin.

Police also removed a woman, identified as Judith Vadnai, 43, of West Orange, N.J., who stood and shouted something about the presidency about the same time. She and Kelley, 23, identified by Capitol police as being from Yuba City, Calif., were released after questioning.
