President Nixon and his entire family flew here yesterday for a holiday weekend stay. Mr. Nixon left the White

House after participating in a Cabinet meeting that lasted nearly two hours and witnessing the swearing-in of Elliot L. Richardson as Attorney General.

Press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler said the Watergate scandal was discussed briefly at the Cabinet session but that the main topic had been talks in Iceland next week with French President Georges Pompidou and in Washington next month with Soviet Communist party

leader Leonid Brezhnev.
"The President," said Ziegler, "again expressed his determination not to be deflected by the events of the time and to move ahead and get the job done in what he

feels is the best interest o the country in domestic and foreign policy programs.'

Accompanying the President to Florida were Mrs Nixon, daughter Julie an son-in-law David Eisenhow er, daughter Tricia and son-in-law Edward Cox.
