## A Request From Costa Rica for Watergate Data

San Jose, Costa Rica

Former President Otilio Ulate said yesterday he has asked President Nixon for all available United States "documentation" that may involve Costa Rica in the Watergate scandal as a result of American financier Robert Vesco's business dealings in this country.

Distributing copies of his May 17 letter to Mr. Nixon, he told a press conference that if he were president of Costa Rica today, "Vesco would be deported immediately."

Ulate is a political foe of president Jose Figureres, who encouraged Vesco, a mutual funds tycoon, to make multi-million dollar investments here. Ulate was president from 1949 to 1953.
