Press Rated on Watergate Issue

The California public is inclined to praise the press for its handling of the Watergate affair.

statewide California Poll survey found that a substantial majority of the public feels that if it hadn't been for the press' activities, the Watergate affair would have remained covered up.

The press has been under severe attack from the Nixon administration, but the public as a whole believes the press would have worked just as hard to uncover wrongdoing no matter who had been President.

Almost twice as many people say that the news coverage of the Watergate affair has been fair and unbiased as say that it has been unfair and biased.

These results were obtained in a statewide survey between May 7th and 17th, in which a representative cross-section of 1043 adults throughout the state was interviewed.

Attitudes toward the press handling of the Watergate affair varies somewhat by political party identification.

Responses to the questions

asked in the survey are shown below:

"Do you feel the news cov-erage that the Watergate matter has received has been generally fair and unbiased, or do you feel the news about Watergate has been presented in an unfair and unbiased way?"
